

Maintenance Team Member (evenings and weekends)

Maintenance Team Member members are expected to prepare fields for games, both for Fastpitch and Slo-Pitch. Preparing the fields for games includes; raking (filling in holes and divots) and tamping the batters boxes, pitching area, and any other area of the field that is low; dragging; lining, inserting bases and pitching rubber; cleaning dugouts; and clearing the infield of water. Due to the nature of the work, Maintenance Team Member members need to be able to stand for long periods of time and be able to lift 50+ pounds. Steel toe boots are required.

Maintenance Team Member members are expected to complete other tasks when not preparing fields for games which include, but are not limited to:

- emptying garbage and recycle bins
- sweeping the concourse (picking up garbage)
- cleaning and stocking washrooms
- power washing

It is important Maintenance Team Member members are adaptable. The tasks listed above are an outline of what applicants can expect to do as a Maintenance Team Member at Softball City. Must be 16 years old or older (drivers licence an asset). However, other tasks will arise.

Knowledge of baseball and softball is considered an asset. Applicants with experience in other sports are also an asset. Maintenance Team Member members will be expected to work independently and show a willingness to take on a variety of tasks.
